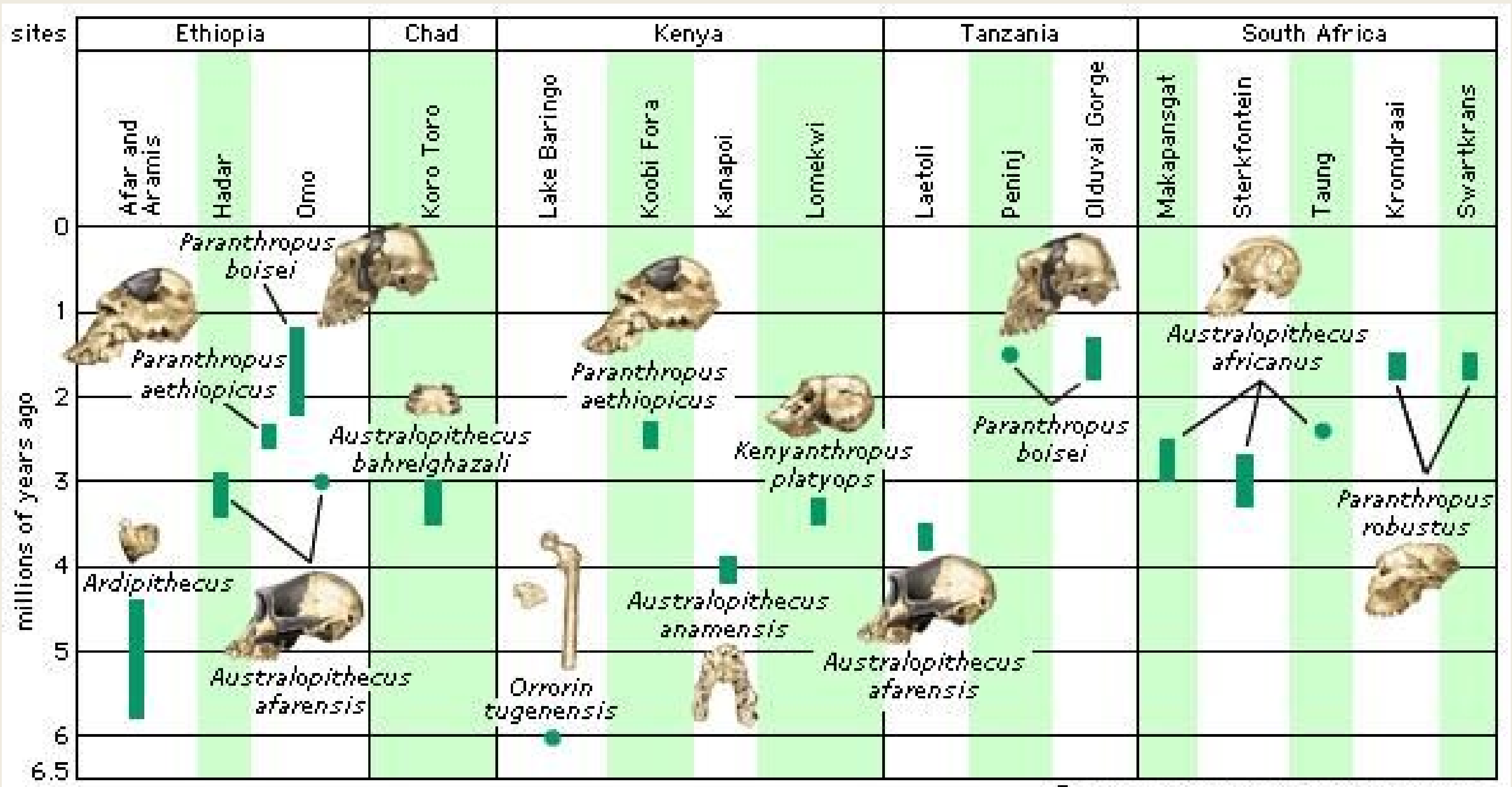

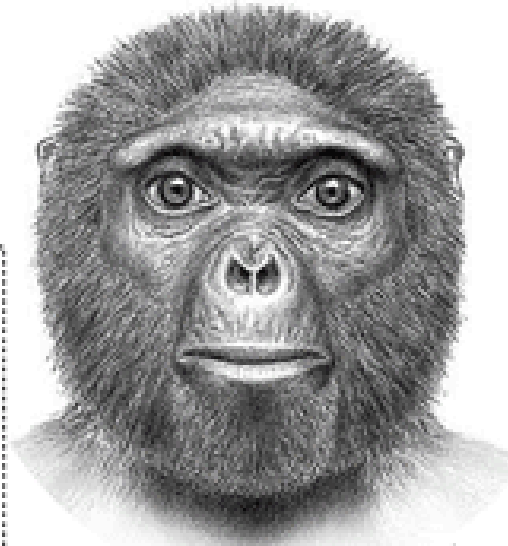
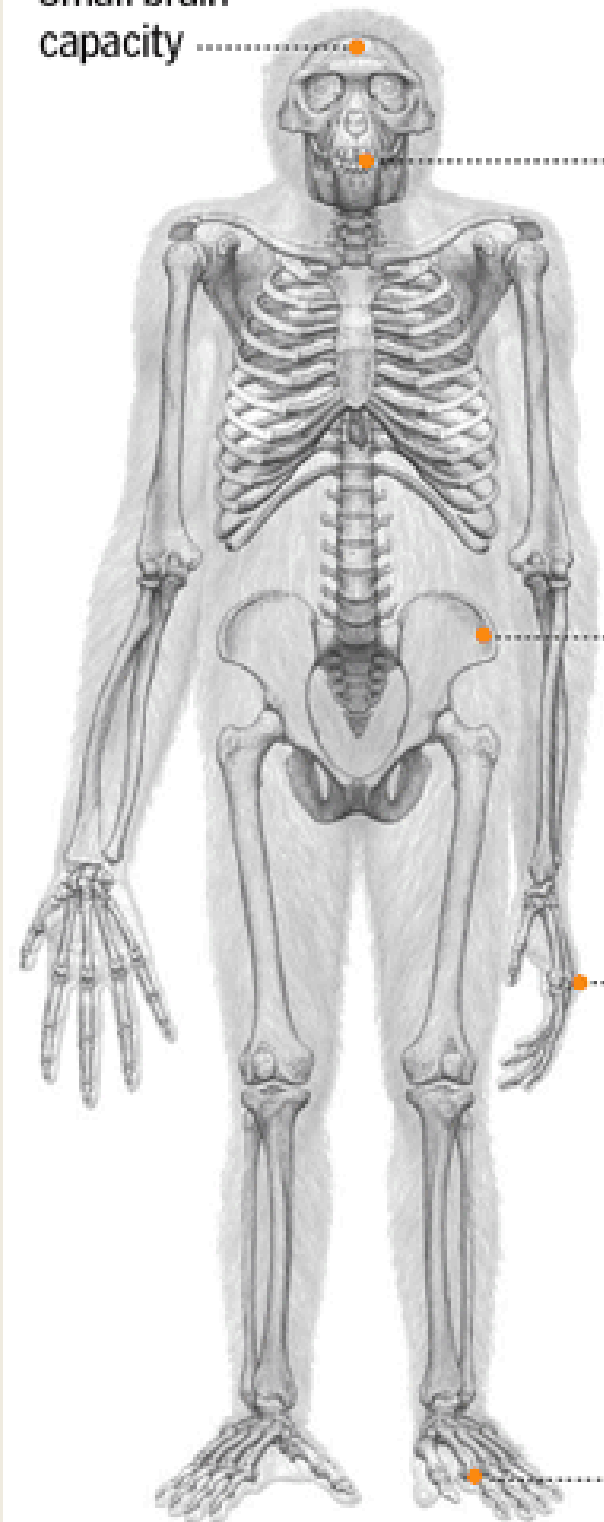

Small brain capacity

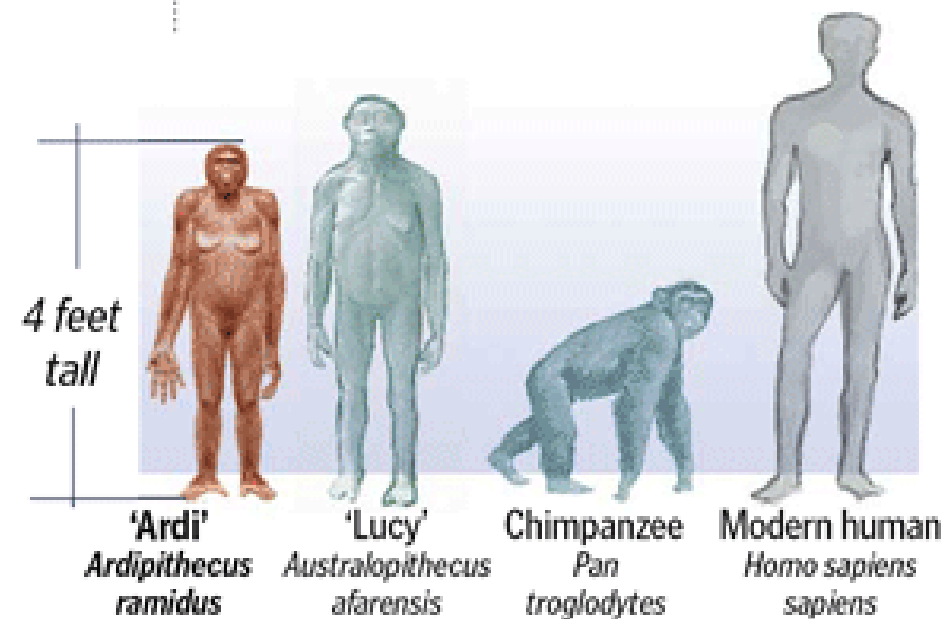
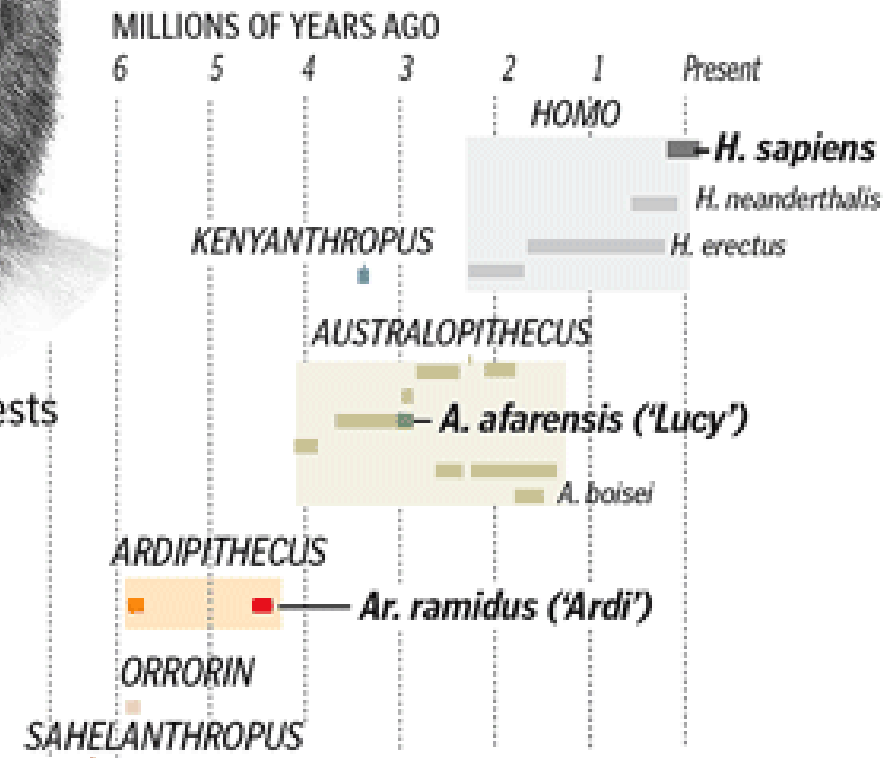


Tooth enamel suggests an omnivore diet, and canine teeth give clues about social behavior.

Pelvis indicates upright walking.

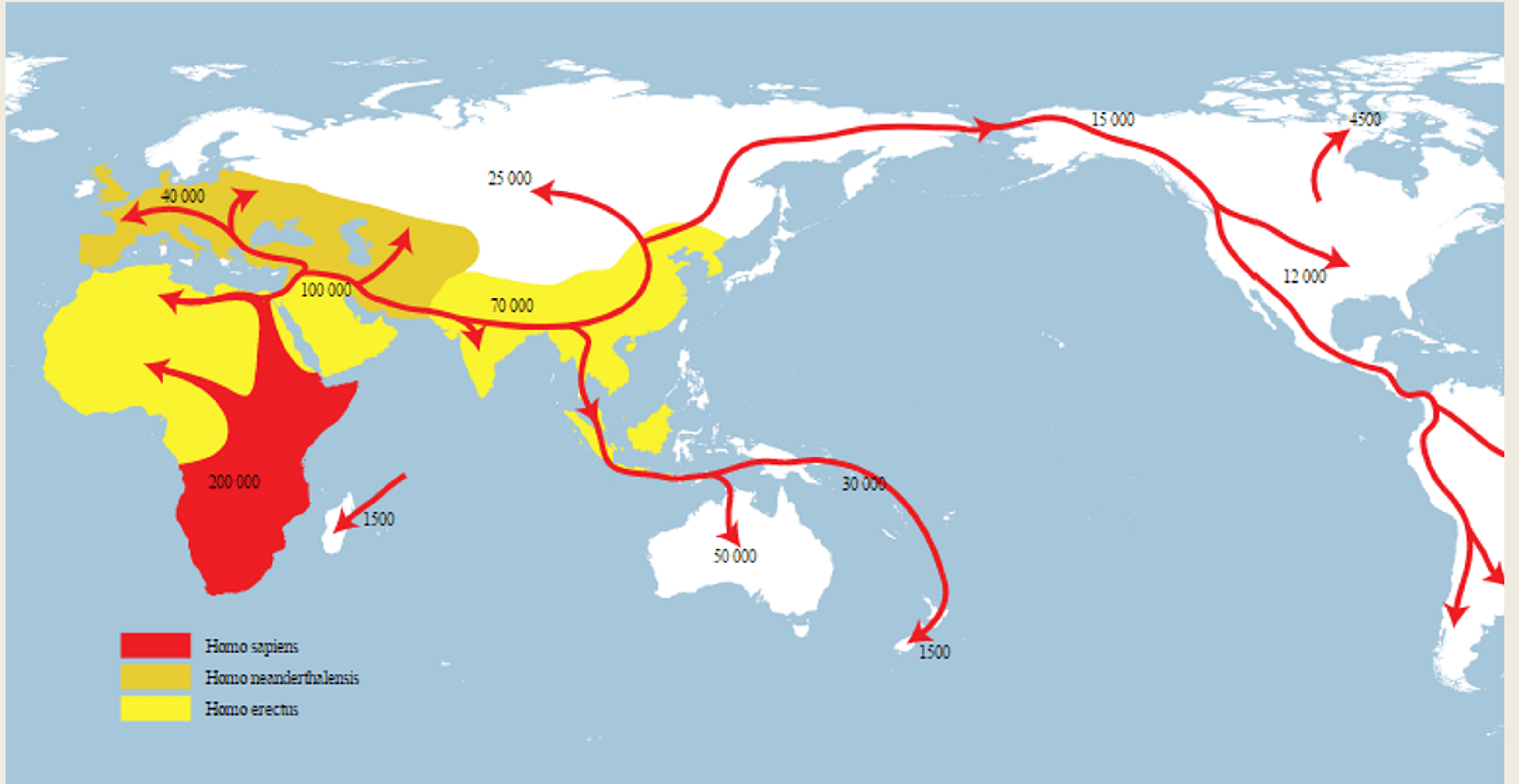
Big hands with no sign of knuckle-walking

Grasping feet adapted for tree climbing.

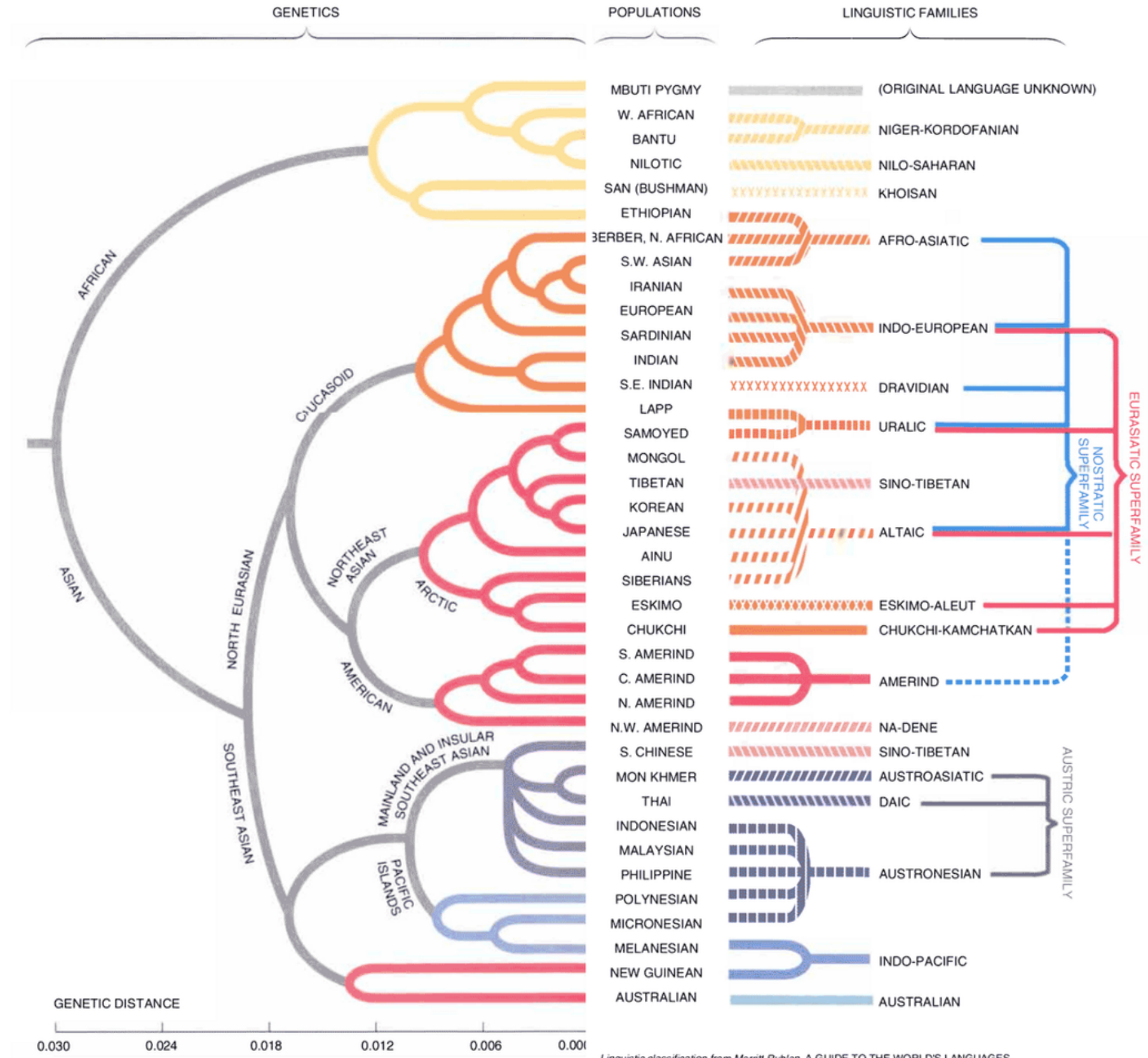
