Use the Universal Dependencies format to parse the following set of sentences (with UDpipe <http://lindat.mff.cuni.cz/services/udpipe/> and the model English-ewt-ud-2.12-230717, flagging “Tag and lemmative” and “Parse”):

1. It was a very nice day.
2. The building is over a garden and has very big windows.
3. The man was running in the street.
4. Several cats are sleeping in the sun.

B

Parse using the same methodology the following sentences and answer the questions below

5. John sees in the park a girl with a telescope.
6. She eats strawberries with cream with a big spoon.
7. Mary bought a skirt yesterday that she doesn't like very much.

Questions:

1. what relations are used to represent a prepositional phrase?
2. trees match your expectations? do they contain errors?
3. are there cases of non-projectivity in the sentences? how were they dealt for?
