Exam rules for the June-September 2021 session

General information

There will be an **online written exam**, with the same format and structure of the sample exams available on Moodle, on the dates published on the ESSE3 platform. An **individual (online) paper presentation** will follow (the exact date of the presentation will be decided upon with each student or group of students). Students are encouraged to choose a paper from the available list before the written exam and inform me by mail (fabio.bagliano@unito.it) about their choice. Already chosen papers will be shown on the “Additional readings for class presentation” section of the Moodle page of the course and marked with an (*).

The students regularly enrolled for the written exam on ESSE3 will receive a **Webex meeting invitation** by the day before the exam date.

Exam questions, answer sheets and hand-in procedure

The **exam question sheet** will be made available on Google Drive at the beginning of the exam, according to detailed instructions that will be released after the registration date. Students will write their answers to exam questions on **sheets of squared paper** and keep their **webcam ON** during the exam. University **smartcards** will be checked before starting the exam.

The exam will last 1 hour and 30 minutes. At the end, students will have to use their smartphones or tablets to **produce one PDF file** of their answer sheets. To this aim, use of the free user-friendly CS CamScanner app is recommended and students are encouraged to practice with the app well before the exam date. The file will then be uploaded on Google Drive, according to the detailed instructions released after the registration deadline.
